



## District 7450 seeks Rotary Team Leader for Goodwill Exchange to Southern Greece

Rotary International District is seeking a Rotarian team leader to lead four outstanding professionals to visit southern Greece for four weeks in April 2010 as part of the Group Study Exchange program of The Rotary Foundation.

Through the program, teams of professionals exchange visits between paired areas in different countries. The awards involve four-week visits, during which team members share homes with Rotary families and have the opportunity to meet their professional counterparts. They will also give presentations to Rotary clubs and other groups about their home country.

The Rotary Foundation provides a round-trip air ticket, and local Rotarians in the host country provide meals, lodging and group travel in their district. The Team leader and members pay for their personal and incidental expenses, as well as travel insurance.

Rotarians interested in applying for Team Leader; should be active Rotarians in their local club and in the district, be able to commit to being away for all 4 weeks, be committed to building a strong team including language lessons for the exchange and be willing to assist the incoming GSE team during their stay and promote GSE throughout the district.
