This past year he built a giant firecracker to signify his club's role in conducting the Firecracker 5K Run, is held on parade day.

Jim is a research engineer with Drummond Scientific Co. in Broomall. He is recognized as the inventor of the electronic pipette, a device that is used in virtually every laboratory in the world.
