

**INDIAN LANE ELEMENTARY EARLY ACT CLUB
TO PARTICIPATE IN RONALD MCDONALD POP TOP COLLECTION
PROGRAM**

The Early Act Club is a Rotary Club at the elementary school level. At Indian Lane Elementary School in Media, PA., this school-wide service club is sponsored by The Rotary Club of Media. The Rotary Clubs of Glen Riddle and Glen Mills and the Indian Lane PTG helped sponsor t-shirts worn by the club members in the Media Halloween Day Parade. The students of this Early Act Club chose CLUB *EARTH* 911 as it's first service project.

The Early Act Club is, also, participating in the Pop Top Collection Program to benefit The Ronald McDonald House of Delaware. Pop Tab containers, provided by third grade student coordinator, Rob Baidokas have been distributed to twenty-five classrooms. Students will be collecting Pop Tabs throughout the school year and the Pop Tabs will be delivered to The Ronald McDonald House of Delaware in June. The amount of money received is determined by the weight of the aluminum collected.

Many Ronald McDonald Houses work with recycling centers to receive money for collecting tabs from aluminum cans, including those from soda cans, vegetable cans and pet food cans. The dollars raised are used for operations and supplies for the Ronald McDonald House.

Since 1991, the Ronald McDonald House of Delaware has provided a “home away from home” for families of seriously chronically ill or injured children receiving treatment at area hospitals by offering nurturing and supportive environments where families can stay together and find comfort.
