You will be able to learn more about the Fair Trade movement from information that will be available at the breakfast. Proceeds from Pancake Day go to the Media Rotary Foundation, a non-profit charitable organization with 501-C-3 status under both Federal and State tax statutes. Since its inception, the Foundation has made grants in excess of \$370,000.
