I was apprehensive about making the ride after my accident last year where I broke my collarbone, 3 ribs, punctured my lung, and ended with 2 herniated Discs in my neck. However once I passed Hammonton (where it happened), I Felt a little more comfortable.



We had 40 Team Riders who made the trip this year. The weather was good. No rain, and temperature was warm. Only bad thing was a head wind when we Were climbing those two humper bridges which was no fun after having Ridden 75 miles. We entered Ocean City and mingled with all the other riders who made the trip. (7,000 total).

We assembled that afternoon at our rooms in Biscayne Hotel and talked about Our



experiences and watched the Penn State Football Game on TV while enjoying beverages and snacks.

Next morning after breakfast, we started the 80 mile return trip into a head wind and fog. Then without mishap, and 5 1/2 hours later, we arrived at Woodcrest Station in Cherry Hill accomplishing our riding goal.



We raised close to \$50,000 this year, and added to the previous 9 rides, our Team Total contributed to Multiple Sclerosis is at a half million dollars which we are very proud of.
