I currently hold the Office of President and C.E.O. and Director of Fidelity Savings, a 122 year old PA Chartered Savings Institution located in Bristol, Bucks County, Pennsylvania. My banking career began in 1974 and I held senior and executive level officer positions in two financial institutions prior to beginning my service with Fidelity Savings. Prior to banking, I was a Partner in a Philadelphia regional public accounting firm, where I started my professional career as a Staff Accountant. My clients included

a variety of industries from manufacturing, printing, college, service professionals, and banking for a public accounting career over 12 years and 13 tax seasons.

I hold a B.S. degree from Drexel University and a diploma in administrative accountancy from Peirce School of Business Administration. I attended the Bank Administration Institute School of Banking at the University of Wisconsin – Madison. I have an active Certified Public Accountant (C.P.A.) License from the Commonwealth of Pennsylvania, which requires 80 hours of Continuing Professional Education every two year licensing period. Drexel University has recognized me with the Blue and Gold award for Professional Attainment.

I am the Past-President of the Financial Managers Society, Philadelphia Chapter; a past Director of the Pennsylvania Association of Community Bankers, in which I also served as Committee Chairpersons on their Marketing, Internal Audit, and Finance and Budget Committees. I am an active member of the American Institute of CPAs and the Pennsylvania Institute of CPAs, and a past member of the Philadelphia and Lehigh Valley Chapters of the Institute of Internal Auditors.
