Project Title: Community School of Bellevue, Haiti – a free school for those who cannot otherwise afford an education.

Description: Physical support for the school and teachers

Why Needed? The pictures show the state of the interior 'walls' – plywood that was re-used to create these walls has deteriorated over the past several years. Additionally, there are very few teaching materials for the teachers – security as well as lack of funds being a reason they have not been purchased in the past. Thanks in part to a district grant, the school now has a new secure concrete office/library/storage area where teachers can store their teaching supplies.

Project's Goal: - replace interior 'walls', fix the roof, supply blackboards, educational materials for the teachers, including but not limited to even simple support like staplers and pencil sharpeners. Depending on the costs for interior walls and patching the roof, we will look into a printer for the office, along with a solar panel with batteries to run it.

Project's Intended Benefits: Although the plywood 'walls' won't minimize the noise level between classrooms, it WILL provide a visual barrier so that students won't be as distracted. Patching the roof will provide a dry classroom, and teacher supplies will allow teachers to use different strategies to engage students. A printer will allow for a teacher to make hand-outs.

Estimated Number of People who benefit from the grant. – All 220+ students at the school as well as the teachers.
