The Gundaker Foundation offers several one-year **Graduate Grants** for post-baccalaureate studies in graduate and professional schools. Attached please find the grant application form for the 2017-2018 academic year. Students who are residents of the 7450 Rotary District or enrolled in an institution located within the District are eligible to apply. To receive the funds they must enroll in a graduate program during the fall term of academic year 2017-2018, either as new or continuing students.

Please encourage students in your service area to take advantage of this opportunity. Also, involve your club members in the process by having them participate in interviewing and selecting your candidates. You can let your community know about the competition in a variety of ways: issue a press release (see attached sample), contact local colleges and universities, connect with your local Rotaract Club, or seek to be interviewed by a local newspaper or radio show.

Applications are due to the Graduate Grants Committee by March 10, 2017.

The Graduate Grants Committee will accept two (2) endorsed candidates from every Rotary Club in the district. Please note that your endorsement implies that you have conducted a selection process before forwarding the application to the Committee. Applications should be submitted via email to theo@earthlink.net in Microsoft Word or PDF format. You must ensure that all elements of the application are included; incomplete applications will not be considered. If you prefer to submit the application on paper, via postal mail, please send only one copy of the documents (see postal address in dbac). Please note that the committee will not accept documents forwarded directly from the applicants.
