for Gundaker Undergraduate Grants

The Gundaker Foundation awards several one-year Undergraduate Grants for full-time junior and senior level undergraduate studies in colleges and universities.

Gundaker Undergraduate Grants range from \$1,000 to \$10,000. They are renewable, provided that recipients resubmit all application materials, receive the endorsement of a District 7450 Rotary Club, and are selected by the Gundaker Foundation for an additional award.

Eligibility

Candidates will be enrolled in the junior or senior year of an undergraduate program in any *college or university in Rotary District 7450*, or be *residents of Rotary District 7450* who will be enrolled in the junior or senior year of an undergraduate program in a college or university anywhere. **CANDIDATES MUST BE FULL-TIME STUDENTS.** Further, a candidate must win approval and be *sponsored by the District 7450 Rotary Club* located closest to the candidate's address. Only two (2) sponsored applications will be accepted by the foundation from each rotary club.

The District includes all of Philadelphia County, much of Chester, Delaware, and Montgomery Counties, and part of lower Bucks County. Attendance at a college or university or residence in the District must be demonstrated to the committee.

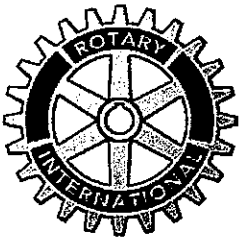
Qualifications for these grants include high academic achievement; a record of leadership in school, community, or other settings; and evidence of involvement in giving service to others. Financial need may also be a consideration.

Applicants may not be a Rotarian or a close relative of any individual who is or has been a Rotarian within the preceding two years.

Application Procedure

Candidates declare their wish to apply for a Gundaker Undergraduate Grant to the Rotary Club in District 7450 closest to the college or university where they study or have residence. ***All application materials must be submitted to that club by approximately January 15th or as designated by the sponsoring club.***

A list of the Rotary Clubs in District 7450 giving the Club's Gundaker Director's name and address, is part of this application package. If you are in doubt about the Club to which you should apply, contact the Gundaker Director of the Club that you think is correct and ask his/her advice.

All applications must be accompanied by a signed affidavit from the Financial Aid Director at the college or university which the applicant intends to attend attesting to the total costs for the coming year, the amount of aid the applicant anticipates committing from his/her own or his/her family resources, and other sources; and the amount of remaining financial aid needed.

All applications must be accompanied by official transcripts of all undergraduate institutions the candidate has attended and by a statement of the Dean of the applicant's current or last school affirming that he or she is in good academic standing and is free from disciplinary sanctions. The application must also be accompanied by a letter from at least one person who attests to the candidate's leadership and/or service activities.

Selection Procedures

Local Rotary Clubs normally conduct interviews through February. Each Rotary Club designates the applicants it will sponsor for grants. Application materials for those candidates are forwarded to the Gundaker Foundation Undergraduate Grant Committee and must be ***received*** by that committee ***no later than February 25th***. All finalists are interviewed by the committee in April. Announcements of grant recipients are made by June. Grant payments are made between June and September for the start of the Fall term. Payments are normally made jointly to the recipient and the college or university.

Mailing

Applicants should mail this application and all other documents to the **GUNDAKER DIRECTOR OF YOUR LOCAL ROTARY CLUB**. It is suggested that the applicant either type the paperwork or use pen with black ink.

Rotary Clubs should send their application(s), accompanied by their written endorsement, and ***four (4) copies*** of all application materials (***including 4 copies of the club endorsement***) to:

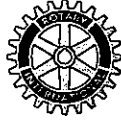
